

## Worship Service

The congregation gathers at 10:30 a.m. each Sunday morning for worship in the 123 year old sanctuary at 124 West Washington Street. Although the service generally offers a traditional approach to worship, a variety of music and worship styles are regularly integrated throughout the service. A children's moment is presented with a theme similar to the context of the sermon. After this message is concluded the children are dismissed to their Sunday School classes where they continue their lesson.



An elevator and covered drive-up entrance is available at the rear of the church for those needing handicapped access to the building on all levels—basement, ground, first floor (worship and offices), and second floor (nursery, Sunday School rooms, choir rooms). Restrooms are located on all levels at the rear of the building near the elevator.



A nursery is provided for infants and toddler on Sunday mornings from 9:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. It is staffed with responsible teens who provide a loving environment, personal care and play activities for the children.
