

Division “D” Deacon Activities

The Division “D” Deacons are presented with actions and decisions that impact not only the lives of members of this congregation, but also those outside of our church.

On a regular basis this group prepares communion for church services, delivers alter flowers each Sunday to shut-ins and the infirm, and organizes and serves dinners for families after a funeral.

The Division “D” Deacons decorate the church for the Christmas season and sponsor the Warm Fuzzy Tree project as one of their major missions. They receive names of families in need and place tags on the sanctuary Christmas tree describing the item needed by each family member. Congregation members remove the tags from the tree, purchase the item(s), wrap them and place them under the tree for distribution to the families. Usually, the gifts are items of necessity. These Deacons also handle special needs or concerns as they arise.

Beginning in 2008, this group has undertaken the responsibility of providing Sunday lunch at the Salvation Army on a rotating basis with other churches.
