Several years ago the youth groups focused their efforts on an ongoing canned food collection for Human Services Food Pantry in Shelbyville. In 2008 one of the shepherd groups has joined the effort to keep this mission going strong. Over the years, the church has contributed over 35,000 items to the pantry.

Our Presbyterian Women organization has adopted a project of collecting toiletries and other personal necessities for women at the Turning Point facility in Columbus and Starting Point in Shelbyville.

One of our members, Chris Browder, is an advocate of the local animal shelter and has initiated a collection of needed items for that organization. This modestly funded shelter must spend most of its income to purchase medical supplies for the pets in residence and prepare the pets for adoption. Donations of such items as paper towels, pet food, and other supplies helps provide necessities for the daily care of animals and frees up more of their funding for medical supplies and services.
