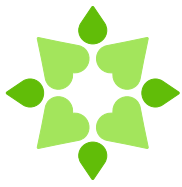

for which he will spend time in Zambia.



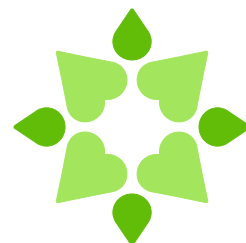

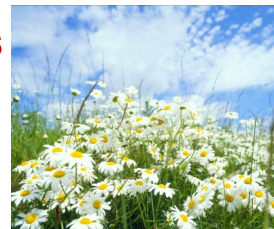
MANY THANKS
