Laiyla and Lainy, and is the grandson of Scott and Kristi McLane. We wish the McLanes all the best as they celebrate their new addition.

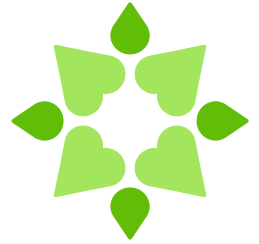
