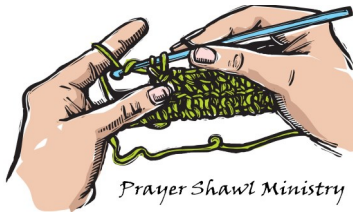
Fourth Tuesday of each month


