

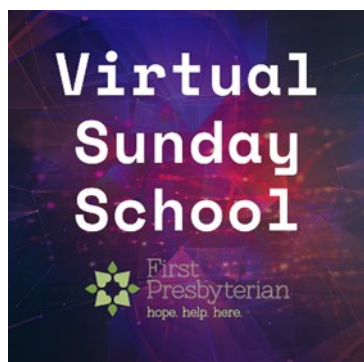

Life Line Screening

- Ultrasound of the lower legs to look for plaque buildup known as peripheral artery disease
- Ultrasound of the shin bone to identify risk for osteoporosis

These 5 vital screenings are offered for only \$149 and take 60-90 minutes to complete. If you register today, you will receive a \$10 discount.

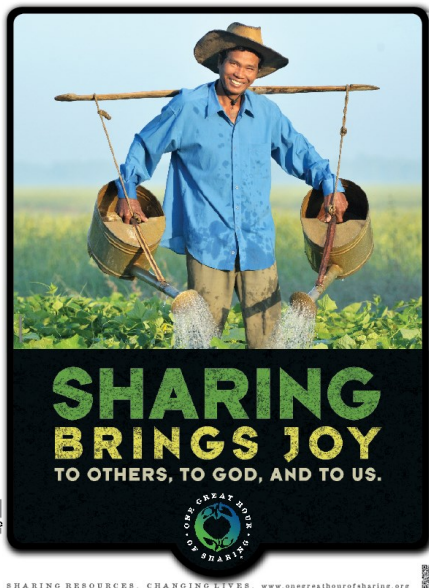
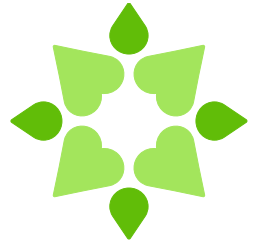

One Great Hour of Sharing

Sharing God's love with our neighbors-in-need around the world by providing relief from natural disasters, food for the hungry, and support for the poor and oppressed.

One other thing that the Covid-19 messed up this year was One Great Hour of Sharing, the special offering we normally collect during Lent.

Around the world, millions of people lack access to sustainable food sources, clean water, sanitation, education, and opportunity. The three programs supported by One Great Hour of Sharing — Presbyterian Disaster Assistance, the Presbyterian Hunger Program, and Self-Development of People — all work in

different ways to serve individuals and communities in need.

Because we have not been in worship, we have not been able to share stories of the ways that OGHS works both in the United States and in the world. We will, therefore, extend the deadline for making a contribution to OGHS until July 31. If you would like to donate, please write a check made out to our church with OGHS in the memo or put cash in an envelope marked OGHS (special envelopes are available in the worship center).

Now that we're open

1. Please stay 6 feet away by sitting in every other pew. Stay back 6 feet when entering, too.
2. Sanctuary doors will be propped open or opened for you.
3. Wearing facemasks will be required. (We have disposable masks available if you forget one)
4. Please stay home if you feel sick.
5. Those who are at higher risk should stay home. Please stay home if you have any doubt.
6. Cover your cough with a tissue then throw it in the trash and wash your hands.
7. We will sanitize the sanctuary and any high touch areas before and after worship.
8. There will be no bulletins, we will not use the hymnals and singing will be different.
9. There will be offering plates at each of the entrances for your offering.
10. Communion cups with a sealed wafer and juice will be available at each entrance when we serve communion.
11. We will have the parlor television, fellowship hall television and one in the youth room available to watch the live stream.
12. We will not have nursery care nor Sunday School for elementary children.
13. No coffee fellowship for now.
14. We will continue streaming our worship service for now.

First Presbyterian Church is live streaming our worship services through the church's **Facebook Live** platform or on YouTube during this time of social distancing. We are still live streaming even though the church is open for worship again. You can join at 10:00am on Sunday or watch at your convenience at another time.

For those of you who do not have access to Facebook or do not have a computer, we are working on getting DVD's made that can be viewed on a portable DVD player. This is still in the works.

The church office continues to be open during this time. If you have a need, a prayer request, questions, or you just want to talk, please give us a call.
