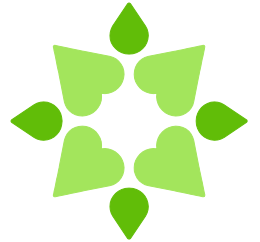

CHOIR PRACTICE RESUMES

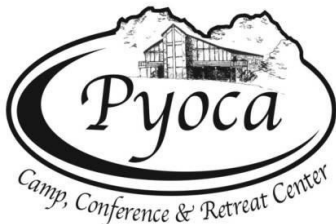
**Begins Wednesday, September 7
