Dinner Before Bedtime - June

Our church is one of the organizations providing the meal delivery for this program, and we have been asked to deliver meals for the month of June. Our hope is to have seven individuals or families who can be available on the same night each week in the month. It would also be nice to have one or two who can fill in if someone has to miss their night.

It does not require interaction with the families. You simply go to the back door of Cracker Barrel at 4:30, press the doorbell, and they load a cooler into your car. You follow the list and place the meals in a cooler on the front porch of the residences on the list, then return the cooler to Cracker Barrel. It takes 45 minutes to an hour to complete the list.
