Per Capita

Every year the local church sends in a "per capita" on each of our church members. The amount for this year of \$41.39 per individual member is set by the Presbyterian Church (USA) and is used by General Assembly, the Synod of Lincoln Trails, and the Presbytery to help cover the costs of running the denomination. Some members in our church elect to pay their own per capita to help offset our church budget. 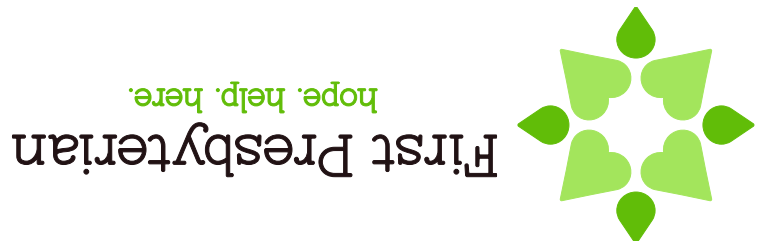

There are still offering envelopes for 2020 available on the counter in Jane's office.



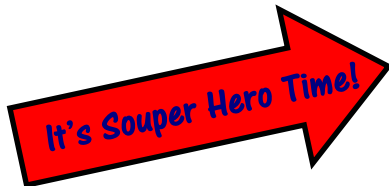
SOUPER BOWL OF CARING

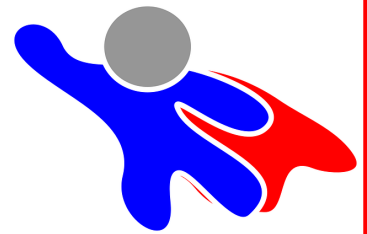
